

Annual Town Meeting , Town of Westbrook, CT
Wednesday, April 7, 2021

The legal voters of the town of Westbrook, CT and others qualified to vote in meetings of said town, met at the Teresa Mulvey Municipal Center, 866 Boston Post Road, Westbrook, CT

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by First Selectman, Noel Bishop. Mr. Bishop led the “pledge of allegiance” and asked for a nomination for moderator of this town meeting.

Paul Winch made a motion to appoint E. Marie Wilson. Motion was seconded by Sid Holbrook and motion passed. Ms. Wilson addressed the town meeting and thanked everyone for the privilege to serve as moderator. Ms. Wilson adopted the procedure of asking everyone present to please stand, state their name and wait to be recognized when commenting or questions arise. Moderator Wilson asked the town clerk to read the call of the meeting.

The call was read by Town Clerk, Joan Angelini, and the call was accepted as read.

Item number One. A motion made by Jeff Kriete to move the question and upon a voice vote it was

RESOLVED: To designate May 4, 2021 as the date for the Annual Town Budget Meeting of the Town of Westbrook, Connecticut in conformance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 7-388 for the purpose of acting upon the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022.

Item Number Two. A motion made by Jeff Kriete to nominate the following residents to the Fair Rent Commission: Richard L. Holton (U), 39 Maple Ridge Road; Sherry A. Seidman (D), 72 Running Pine Road; Katherine A. Sullivan (D), 98 Meadowlark Lane; Chris Ehlert (D), 96 Kenrose Terrace. Upon a motion made by Sid Holbrook to close nominations and a “hand count vote,” the motion passed, and it was

RESOLVED: To nominate and elect four (4) Fair Rent Commissioners to serve for term of four (4) years to May 15, 2025 pursuant to section 2-202 of Westbrook Code of Ordinances.

Item Number Three. Nominations were made and a “hand count vote” resulted in the following: Sid Holbrook (R), 455 Essex Road – 19 Votes; Brittany G. Cusano (U), 17 Sagamore Terrace Road – 15 Votes and Carrie L. Campi (U), 66 Ortner Drive – 3 Votes. Upon a hand count, it was

RESOLVED: To nominate and elect two (2) Fire Commissioners to serve for a term for three (3) years to April 30, 2024 pursuant to Section 7-21 of the Westbrook Code of Ordinances.

Item Number Four. Nominations for the Forest Commission were made as follows: Robert J. Corson (U), 15 Old Kelsey Point Road; Jeff Kriete (U), 342 Grove Beach Road, North and Mark D. Richard (R), 261 Spencer Plains Road. Upon a “hand count vote” it was

RESOLVED: To nominate and elect three (3) Forest Commissioners to serve for a term of three years (3) to April 21, 2024 pursuant to Section 9-162 of the Westbrook Code of Ordinances.

Item Number Five. Kevin M. Blair, Chairman of Westbrook Park & Rec Board made the following nominations: Kevin M. Blair (R), 553 Essex Road; Matthew J. LaSota, (U) 1393 Boston Post Road; Philip B. Cocchiola (U), 44 Salt Island Road; Melissa R. Ehlert (U), 96 Kenrose Terrace; Michael J. Esposito (R), 149 Fairview Road; Jan C. Ulanowicz (U), 263 East Pond Meadow Road; Abigail F. Fredrickson (R), 125 East Pond Meadow Road; Gregory S. Carlo (R), 530 Toby Hill Road; Jodi M. Ouellette (U), 867 West Pond Meadow Road. Nominations were closed and upon a vote by hand count, it was

RESOLVED: To nominate and elect nine (9) members to the Board of Recreation to serve for a term of three (3) years from May 13, 2021 to May 13, 2024, pursuant to Section 14-23 of the Westbrook Code of Ordinances.

Moderator Wilson asked for a motion to adjourn; the meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
