H. Plaut reported that he has ordered the Port-a-Potty for May. He has put in No Wake Markers, and he put in White #6. Also, he put in 4 "Danger Rocks" Markers and Red #6.

2. Straighten out Patchogue Moorings

H. Plaut stated that he plans to realign the Patchogue River Moorings with D. Russell. R. Stevenson and E. Cusson offered to help as well. E. Cusson would like to have the moorings realigned before Memorial Day.
