Resident Input Sought For Westbrook Plan of Conservation and Development Update

Westbrook, CT- How should Westbrook guide future development? Planning officials in Westbrook are looking for public input as part of the Town's update of the 1990 Plan of Conservation and Development.

Westbrook residents will get the opportunity to discuss issues and concerns, likes and dislikes, at a public informational meeting scheduled by the Planning Commission as part of the process to prepare the 2010 Plan of Conservation and Development. The meeting is scheduled for August 25th at 7:00 p.m. at the Mulvey Municipal Center, 866 Boston Post Road.

Planning Commission Chair Marilyn Ozols commented "This is the Town's document; it will become Westbrook's vision for the future. We want to hear from as many people as possible, now and as the Plan moves forward. I urge everyone to participate in the process."

Residents in Westbrook are encouraged to bring their views, concerns, and questions to this and subsequent workshops to ensure that the 2010 Plan of Conservation and Development accurately reflects the community's vision as it is used to guide future conservation and development activity over the next decade and beyond.

The meeting will be conducted by Planimetrics; the planning consulting firm from Avon, Connecticut selected by the Town to coordinate the preparation of the Plan.
