The legal voters of the Town of Westbrook, Connecticut and all others qualified to vote in meetings of said Town are hereby notified and warned that a Special Town Meeting will be held in the Multi Media Room of the Teresa Mulvey Municipal Center, 866 Boston Post Road, Westbrook, CT on March 27, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. to act on the following matters:

1. To consider and act upon a resolution to approve the grant of an easement to Maureen A. Morris, owners of 105 Old Mail Trail, over a portion of a public right-of-way owned by the Town of Westbrook and known as "Old Mail Trail" of the right to lay, install, maintain, operate, construct, use, alter, repair, and replace piping, conduit, wires, air lines, and control apparatus under and through the area labeled "Proposed Easement to Parcel 89, 105 Old Mail Trail over Land of the Town of Westbrook for Sanitary Sewer Line" as shown on a map entitled "Existing Conditions Map Prepared for Maureen Morris TM 195, Lot 89 105 Old Mail Trail Westbrook Connecticut Date Sept 16, 2016 Scale 1"=10'." A copy of the map and proposed Grant of Easement is on file with the Town Clerk for public review.

2. To consider and act upon a proposed amendment to Chapter 5, Article 1, Section 5-4, of the Westbrook Code of Ordinances to amend the permit fees related to Building Department applications. A copy of the proposed fee schedule is on file with the Town Clerk for public review.

3. To consider and act upon the adoption of Amended Resolution for Providing Tax Relief for Elderly Homeowners pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 12-129n, as recommended by the Board of Finance and Board of Selectmen. A copy of the Resolution is on file with the Town Clerk for public review.

4. To consider and act upon the acceptance of a certain easement for access and parking purposes from CMS Real Estate, LLC on property known as 20 Westbrook Place as recommended by the Board of Selectmen and the Planning Commission. A copy of the Easement is on file with the Town Clerk for public review.
