By signing of this application, the applicant agrees and understands that the harbormaster shall have placed a mooring buoy and tackle which shall be compliant with the regulations of the Harbor Commission and the State of Connecticut at the appropriate location. The applicant further agrees that he will abandon such mooring buoy and tackle upon relinquishing the permit

The Town makes no representations as to the condition or usability of any such abandoned mooring buoy and tackle, and the permit holder shall use same at his own risk and shall be solely liable for any damages arising from or as a result of his use of said mooring buoy and tackle. All boats in the mooring field must have hull and liability insurance. The Town is not responsible for damage by fire, storm, or theft and the owner agrees to hold the Town harmless in the event of such an occurrence. Vessels moored in this field must be removed in the event of a hurricane or named storm.

The applicant agrees to pay an annual maintenance fee of \$250 payable to the Town of Westbrook, due January 1 each year. There will be no separate annual bill for this maintenance. Failure to pay the fee within 45 days of that date will invalidate the mooring permit, and the permit and associated mooring tackle are deemed abandoned by the holder/owner and available for reassignment. The fee covers the removal, inspection, and repair of the mooring tackle assigned to the permit holder. The Harbormaster shall be responsible for determining when such maintenance shall occur and coordinating such work. It is the intent that all moorings shall be removed and repaired at the same time to facilitate such work

The mooring permit is valid only for the above listed boat which must be owned by the permit holder. Moorings unoccupied for a total of more than 60 days from May 15 to October 1 shall be deemed abandoned, and ready for transfer to a new permit holder unless otherwise agreed with the Harbormaster. All transfers of mooring permits shall be performed by the harbormaster using a waiting list at the town clerk's office for new assignments.
