



TOWN OF WESTBROOK
HARBOR MANAGEMENT COMMISSION

OPENING: The regular scheduled meeting of the Westbrook Harbor Commission was held on Tuesday, May 28, 2013 at the Teresa Mulvey Municipal Center, 866 Boston Post Road, Westbrook, CT. The meeting was held in the South Conference Room and called to order by Chairman, Mike Farrell at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Following the pledge of allegiance, a roll call was taken and in attendance were: Chairman, Mike Farrell, Harbormaster, Bruce Lawrence; Bill Angelini, Gary Nolf, John Rie, Jeff Gordon, Evan Cusson, Ronny Stevenson, Keith Rich and E. Torrance Downes. Absent: Brian Faucher. Also in attendance, Rives Potts, Pilots Point Marina.

BILLS TO BE PAID: Approved for payment were the following invoices: 1) Conn. River Dock and Dredge for \$3,900.00; 2) Ronny Stevenson for \$960.00 for two open moorings, hauling & setting; 3) hometown sanitation for \$90.00 for the month of April, 2013.

Motions to pay were made by Bill Angelini and Gary Nolf for items #1 and #2; approval for item #3 was made by Ronny Stevenson and seconded by John Rie.

MINUTES: The minutes of the April 23, 2013 meeting were read and approved. Motion to approve minutes was made by Ronny Stevenson and seconded by John Rie.

CORRESPONDENCE: Chairman Farrell submitted two "Certificates of Permission" to be filed in the Town Clerk's Office.

NEW BUSINESS: Budget Review; Beach Moorings; Sign at Channel Entrance

Discussion about using monies for signage. Bill Angelini reported his discussion with Rich Holton of Enterprise Computers regarding the Town's Website and putting a sign on the website as a tool for visitors. John Rie stated that Mike Morrissey of Pier 76 Marina would like to be included in the sign. There was more discussion about the names of marinas south of route one. It was decided that the name of the Westbrook Harbor Master and phone number would be part of the sign. A discussion of materials to be used and a question of size of 4' x 8' being large enough. It was mentioned that no transient boaters would be heading to Pier 76. Rives Potts asked if the Rock Buoys should be bigger. It was decided that a reflective red and white sign would be needed and the project needs to be billed out by June 30, 2013.

Bill Angelini agreed to do the research and get some artwork with directionals for the North Yard, Fuel, Etc.

HARBORMASTERS REPORT: Bruce Lawrence reported the moorings have been moved and Chanel markers are in.

Beach Moorings – West Beach. Mushroom vs. pyramid moorings. Any mooring needs an approval of the Harbor Master. Bruce will be attending the Council of Beaches Meetings to review these items and Keith Rich will also attend.

OLD BUSINESS


HARBOR MANAGEMENT UPDATE
