D. Staff Report:

The report was distributed and discussed. There was discussion regarding 553 Essex Road. Richard Snarski has looked at the property and has provided a restoration plan. Alliance Bank is looking to do the restoration prior to the sale of the house.

VOTED: Unanimously to accept and agree to the restoration plan provided by Soil Scientist Richard Snarski for 553 Essex Road and that Alliance Bank must complete the work prior to the sale of the property or the new property owner must complete the work within 30 days of purchase, or a cease and desist will be issued on the property.

E. Commission Member Reports:

* Planning Commission – Carole Ketelsen stated that the Planning Commission, per Legal Counsel, is working on clearly stating that there is no town liability to non-town owned roads. Ms. Ketelsen also stated that the Planning Commission can no longer force a developer to put in sidewalks or any other improvements on any location except the development property.

* Zoning Commission – Chris Ehlert stated that the Zoning Commission is currently working with the Planning Commissions input to revise the current regulations. Mr. Ehlert further stated that he will be stepping down as the Zoning Commission representative to the IWWC because of other obligations. There are a couple of members of the Zoning Commission who will be willing to take his place.

VOTED: Unanimously to send a letter of recommendation to the Zoning Commission to release the bond for Off-Site Drainage Improvements.
