The legal voters of the Town of Westbrook, Connecticut and all others qualified to vote in meetings of said Town are hereby notified and warned that a Special Town Meeting will be held in the Multi Purpose Room of the Mulvey Municipal Center, 866 Boston Post Road, Westbrook, Connecticut on Thursday, May 20, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. to act on the following matters:

Item 1: To consider and act upon the following resolution, as recommended by the BOS and the BOF:

RESOLVED: That a sum not to exceed \$4,350.00 be appropriated from Contingency to the Tax Collector's Refund Line to address the Military Historians LLC tax appeal.

Item 2: To consider and act upon the following, as recommended by the BOS and the BOF:


RESOLVED: That the Town accept grants from the Westbrook Foundation in the amount of \$40,000 for the installation of a 3rd Pickle Ball Court, \$5,352.19 to support the purchase of equipment needed to successfully meet guidelines to re-open the Senior Center and \$8,500 for the purchase of a Police Thermal Camera , and hereby authorizes appropriate Department Heads to execute such documents as may be necessary to accept said grants and receive such funds; furthermore, to appropriate said amounts to the Grant Account Line.

Item 3: To consider and act upon the following, as recommended by the BOS:


RESOLVED: That the Town apply for a Small Cities Grant in the amount of \$1,500,000 for improvements to the Worthington Manor Housing Facility and to authorize the First Selectman to execute all documents as may be necessary to apply for such grant.
